The season is rolling right along and the summer weather has arrived! With my summer help back, we have been busy getting caught up with mowing and trimming on the golf course. We have a few small projects we will be working on thru the summer. The new hole number signs were installed and look great.

The golf course overall is doing great from our crazy spring weather where it was up and down on a regular basis. Number 13 fairway is growing in nicely. It is about a month behind where I would like it, but that is from the poorly timed downpours of rain we received over the spring. Both times I hydroseeded we received torrential downpours within 5 days of seeding and then while seed was germinating. This washed away a lot of seed and seedlings. It is now coming in nicely. We will topdress it and fill in some of the low areas and spot seed as needed.



It is getting close to that time to be thinking about grub control for those who do their own lawns. I have been watching and I have found a few white grubs but not many. Grub control is needed to control these pests as you can have your lawn looking beautiful and in just a matter of a couple days it looks like it is drying out. If this occurs, just tug on the area and if the grass has no resistance and just pulls up, you will likely see the grubs below. If this is the case, you will need to use something else besides your normal preventative grub control to get rid of them.

We have a busy summer ahead! Enjoy the golf course!

MEMBERSHIP INFO

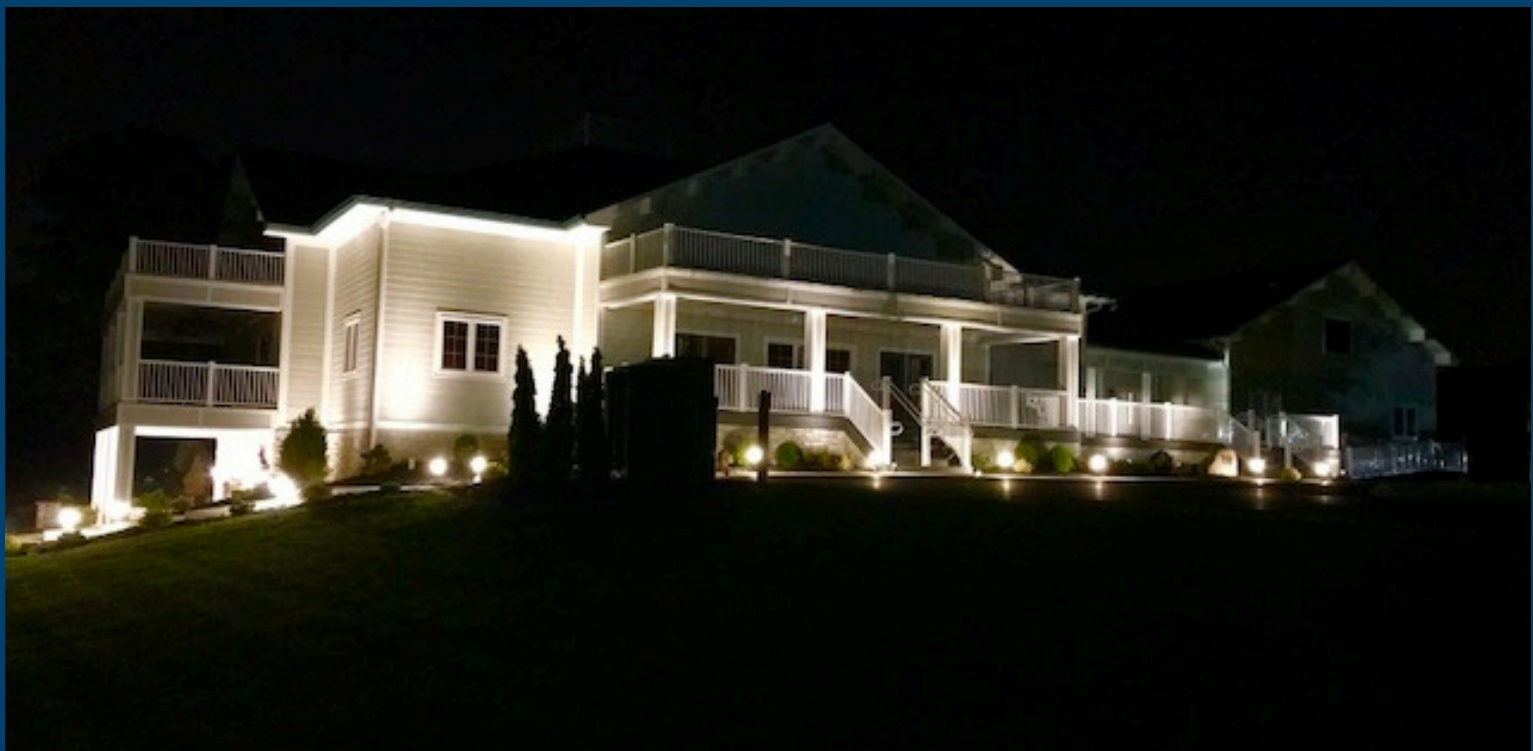

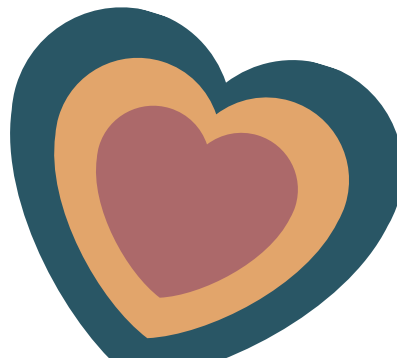
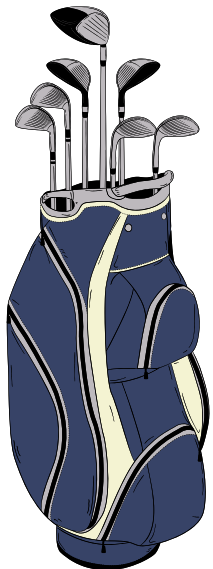
